The National Museum library was established to support the information needs of the institution and to deepen public knowledge by providing open access to relevant sources of information mainly about cultural and historical facts, artifacts, heritage and natural history of the Philippines.

The library is committed in delivering effective, efficient and quality services to its users with over 5, 000 collections of materials in various formats such print (books, periodicals, journals, etc.), non- print (sound recordings, audio-visuals, etc.) and special collections including works from archaeology, ethnology, botany, zoology, marine underwater and other museum divisions.

It is located at the ground floor of the National Museum of Anthropology and is open to the public and those within the community who wish to conduct research, study and leisure reading.

LIBRARY SERVICE

- Room reading, study, and research

Answers to library queries are provided by a reference librarian to help users in the retrieval of information they need. Question that are not related to the library will be directed to the concerned divisions.

- Borrowing, Circulation, & Renewal

The resources of the National Museum Library are free of use to the public. National Museum employees may borrow and check out library materials.

- Request for National Museum Publications

Library patrons or an Institution may request a copy of available National Museum publications by sending a formal request to the Central Library and Archives Section. All request should be received by the Central Library and Archives Section at least 15 days before the requesting agency expect to receive the items.

- Library Orientation

The National Museum Library provides orientation and information literacy programs to nearby schools.
